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# Magnums

“A magnum is the perfect amount of wine for two people... if only one of them is drinking.”

*Winston Churchill*

When it comes to wine, bigger often means better. There is something about a magnum that screams “celebration”. There is a certain theatre to ordering and pouring them, and the presence of an oversized bottle of wine is always going to make the ideal centrepiece of any special gathering.

There’s also good science to prove that drinking from magnums produces a better taste. As there’s more wine in the bottle and less ullage (empty space between the wine and the cork), it means a proportionately smaller amount of air in the bottle – which is what causes ageing; through oxidation. The result is therefore a more prolonged and graceful maturation, and the wine will often develop greater nuances and more complex flavours than wine aged in standard bottles. As a result of this aging potential, producers typically only choose their best wines to be bottled into such larger formats.

**501 Conde Valdemar, DO Rioja Crianza** 2016 £68.50

After a winter with normal temperatures and rainfall for D.O.Ca Rioja, high temperatures in spring and summer marked this year, as well as the absence of rain at the most dangerous times for the vineyard. These factors led to very healthy vines, but the harvest was brought forward three weeks on average. As a result, this year was rated as a very good one in the area, with the only drawback of not reaching full ripeness. Therefore, the wines from this vintage are those typical from Rioja, with a slightly higher alcoholic strength and a good balance between acidity and ripening

**502 Barolo DOCG, San Silvestro Patres, Piemonte** 2017 £105.00

A stylish Barolo, with expressive aromas of dried fruit, roses and tar. The deep fruits are layered with minerality on the smooth and mouth-filling palate and sweet tannins weave through to a very long, elegant finish.

**503 The Chocolate Block, Boekenhoutskloof, Franschhoek** 2018 £127.50

The palate is medium bodied with sappy black fruit, a fine bead of acidity, and quite saline and spicy in the mouth. The fresh, quite pure finish lingers in the mouth. This is a very impressive wine.

**504 Château Paloumey, Cru Bourgeois, Haut-Médoc** 2007 £125.00

Deep colour. Extremely ripe nose conjuring up jammy fruits. Supple, mellow, pleasant attack leading to a more streamlined mid palate.

## Wines of the Month

### 56 Pinot Nero, Borgo Magredo, Friuli-Venezia Giulia. Italy, 2019

The prince of elegance among red-grape varieties comes from vines that are 20 to 25 years old, cultivated directly by the company's agronomists. In the glass, it's a nice red hue that's not particularly intense, as is typical of Pinot Nero. It gives off intense scents recalling small red berries, cherries, and wild violets. Well-balanced on all levels, it has good persistence and excellent aromatic nature.

### 126 Chardonnay, Altùris Nice Wine, Friuli-Venezia Giulia Italy, 2019

It has a deep straw yellow colour with golden highlights. The nose is elegant and fruity with pleasant vanilla hints and bread aromas. Golden delicious apple, ripe pear, a subtle note of pineapple and warm lemon on the palate as well as notes of hazelnut and toasted almond. It also shows a lot of freshness and persistence (but not lean) with smoky hints. Impressive structure, buttery, dry with a viscous texture and is an absolute pleasure to behold in the glass
