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# Magnums

***“A magnum is the perfect amount of wine for two people... if only one of them is drinking.”***

**Winston Churchill**

When it comes to wine, bigger often means better. There is something about a magnum that screams “celebration”. There is a certain theatre to ordering and pouring them, and the presence of an oversized bottle of wine is always going to make the ideal centrepiece of any special gathering.

There’s also good science to prove that drinking from magnums produces a better taste. As there’s more wine in the bottle and less ullage (empty space between the wine and the cork), it means a proportionately smaller amount of air in the bottle – which is what causes ageing through oxidation. The result is therefore a more prolonged and graceful maturation, and the wine will often develop greater nuances and more complex flavours than wine aged in standard bottles. As a result of this aging potential, producers typically only choose their best wines to be bottled into such larger formats. We are huge fans!

**501 Conde Valdemar, DO Rioja Crianza** 2018 £79.50

After a 2017 winter with normal temperatures and rainfall for Rioja, high temperatures in spring and summer marked out this year alongside the absence of rain at the most dangerous times for the vineyard. These factors though led to very healthy vines, but the harvest was brought forward three weeks on average. As a result, this year was rated as a very good one in the area, with the only drawback of not reaching full ripeness. Therefore, the wines from this vintage are those typical from Rioja, with a slightly higher alcoholic strength and a good balance between acidity and ripening.

**502 Barolo DOCG, San Silvestro Patres, Piemonte** 2019 £135.00

A stylish Barolo, with expressive aromas of dried fruit, roses and tar. The deep fruits are layered with smooth minerality on the mouth-filling palate. Sweet tannins weave through to a very long, elegant finish.

Average score of 97/100 points

**504 Château Puygueraud, Francs Cotes de Bordeaux, France** 2016 £125.00

Medium to deep garnet-purple coloured, the 2016 Puygueraud comes bursting out of the glass with notions of red and blackcurrants, blackberries and dried Provence herbs with a hint of charcoal. Medium to full-bodied, firm and chewy, it has a good core of fruit and a savoury finish.

Average score of 90/100 points

**505 Château Lynch-Bages, 5ème Cru Classé JEROBOAM 3L** 2000 £3995.00

Beginning to open magnificently! The still dense purple-coloured 2000 reveals a blossoming bouquet of blackberries, cassis, graphite and pen ink. Full-bodied with velvety tannins that have softened beautifully over the decades, this wine is still an adolescent, but it exhibits admirable purity, texture, mouthfeel and power combined with elegance. One of the all-time great examples of Lynch- Bages.

**206 Taittinger Brut Réserve Champagne NV £82.50 £18.50**

The brilliant body is golden yellow in colour. The bubbles are fine, while the foam is discreet yet lingering. The nose, very open and expressive, delivers aromas of fruit and brioche. It also gives off the fragrance of peach, white flowers, and vanilla pod. The entry onto the palate is lively, fresh and in total harmony. This is a delicate wine with flavours of fresh fruit and honey.

**216 Forget Brimont 1er Cru Brut Rosé Champagne NV £82.50 £18.50**

Elegant salmon colour. Fine persistent bubbles. Very fresh nose. Large range of small red fruits including mulberry, raspberry and redcurrant. Lovely intense aromas and a refreshing first impression on the palate with flavours of ripe red fruit. A harmonious balance between roundness and freshness.

Terre di Montelusa, Puglia

One of those lovely, super easy reds that we keep going back to. As such we think it's pretty special. No shortage of the classic peppery wild hedgerow fruits with a bit of fig jam and maraschino cherry on the end.

Heartland Spice Trader, Langhorne Creek,

This is shown on the nose with layers of dry herb and dark spice enveloped by black fruit. The dense blackcurrant character dominates the mouth, while pepper and sweet spices dance to the tune of a long finish.

Vat 8, Deen de Bertoli, Victoria

Soft supple Shiraz, dangerously moreish by the glass. Bright, aromatic and juicy on the nose with just a touch of naughty spicy bacon and white pepper.

**65 Rioja Crianza Spain 2020 £38.50 £11.50 £15.50**

Vina Bujanda

A well-made, traditional style Rioja aged in American oak for 12 months giving it notes of toast and coconut on the nose and a creamy spice and vanilla seasoned palate. Utterly smooth and seamless. A real showstopper...
